

ORDINANCE NO. 5151-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 17-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, KANSAS, TO ADOPT THE 40th EDITION OF THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES; REPEALING SECTION 17-101 OF SAID CODE AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 5127-23; REPEALING SECTION ONE ORDINANCE NO. 5127-23; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5144-24.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 17-101 of the Code of the City of Newton, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

17-101. Incorporating Uniform Public Offense Code.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Newton, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities," 40th Edition, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by Ordinance No. 5151-24 of the City of Newton, Kansas," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted, deleted, modified or changed clearly marked to show any such omissions, deletions, modifications or changes, and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open for inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge, and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of this Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Uniform Public Offense Code similarly marked as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 5127-23 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 5144-24 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in THE NEWTON KANSAN, the official newspaper of said City.
