## **ORDINANCE NO. 5152-24**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, KANSAS, TO ADOPT THE 51<sup>st</sup> EDITION OF THE STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES; REPEALING SECTION 21-101 OF SAID CODE AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 5126-23 AND REPEALING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 5126-23.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1.** Section 21-101 of the Code of the City of Newton, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

21-101. Standard Traffic Ordinance incorporated; traffic infractions and traffic offenses.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic upon the highways of the City that certain standard traffic ordinance known as "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," 51<sup>st</sup> Edition, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except for such articles, sections, parts or portions as are omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 5152-24 of the City of Newton, Kansas," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted, deleted, modified or changed clearly marked to show any such omissions, deletions, modifications or changes, and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open for inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge, and all administrative departments of the City charged with the enforcement of this Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked as may be deemed expedient.

**SECTION 2.** Section 1 of Ordinance No. 5126-23 is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in THE NEWTON KANSAN, the official newspaper of the City.
