ORDINANCE NO. 5156-24

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY, AMENDING CHAPTER TWENTY ONE OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, KANSAS PERTAINING TO PARKING.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Newton, Kansas hereby finds that to protect and preserve public health, safety and welfare, it is necessary to regulate traffic within the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter XXI, Article 1 of the Code of the City of Newton, Kansas, is hereby amended to include the following supplement:

21-106a. Same

- (a) All of Pine Street between East Seventh Street and Broadway;
- (b) East side of Pine Street from the south line of East Seventh Street for a distance of 140 feet;
 - (c) South side of Seventh Street from North Pine 165 feet eastward;
- (d) South side of Seventh Street from North Walnut approximately 384 feet eastward to the K&O Railroad.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after summary publication in the official newspaper of the City.
